County Veterans Affairs Officer of the Year.

This award recognizes a County Veterans Affairs Officer who has made outstanding contributions to the Veterans in the State of South Carolina and the Veterans Advocate profession, demonstrates exceptional service to their community, and has contributed to the betterment of the SC Association of County Veterans Affairs Officers (SCACVAO).

Purpose

To establish a prestigious State award for an active County Veterans Affairs Officer who has performed the duties of his or her office in the highest professional manner as well as enhance the Office of Veterans Affairs.

Awards Panel

Comprised of three members (a) two past presidents of the SCACVAO (b) the current President of the SCACVAO will be the chairman of this panel.

Categories

An award will be given to an active County Veterans Affairs Officer, who is a member in good standing of the SCACVAO, from any county in the State of South Carolina.

Criteria

This award is intended to recognize a County Veterans Affairs Officer who has shown unusual initiative and imagination in the performance of his/ her duty. Long years of service are a consideration, but not the determining factor. Any involvement in the community that goes beyond the responsibilities of the office will be considered. Those actions the County Veterans Affairs Officer took to improve the stature of the Office of Veterans Affairs locally and statewide, as well as any contributions on the national level and to SCACVAO will be given a high priority.

Qualifications

A candidate must be an appointed County Veterans Affairs Officer; a member in good standing of the SCACVAO.

Application

Complete the attached form and submit with supporting documentation listed below.

The nomination must include the following:

Description of meritorious activities and major accomplishments and description of involvement with state as well as the SCACVAO. The nominations are due (NLT) November 1st each year and will be presented at each Spring Training of the SCACVAO
