This award recognizes a County Veterans Affairs Officer and or Deputy, Claims Assistants who have made outstanding contributions to the Veterans in the State of South Carolina and the Veterans Advocate profession, by exceptional service to their county, State of South Carolina and the SC Association of County Veterans Affairs Officers (SCACVAO) for a period of Ten, Fifteen and Twenty or more years of service.

**Purpose**

To establish a longevity award for a County Veterans Affairs Officer and Deputy, or Claims Assistants who has performed the duties of his or her office in the highest professional manner as well as enhance the Office of Veterans Affairs for a period of Ten, Fifteen and Twenty or more years of service.

**Awards Panel**

Comprised of two members (a) the current membership chairman (b) the current president of the SCACVAO.

**Categories**

An award will be given to an active County Veterans Affairs Officer and or Deputy, Claims Assistants who is a member in good standing of the SCACVAO, from any county in the State of South Carolina.

**Criteria**

This award is intended to recognize a County Veterans Affairs Officer and or Deputy, Claims Assistants who has retired as a County Veterans Affairs Officer with Ten, Fifteen, Twenty or more years of service.

**Qualifications**

A candidate must be an appointed County Veterans Affairs Officer and or Deputy, Claims Assistants and a member in good standing of the SCACVAO.
