State Salary Supplements for County Officials

Auditors/Treasurers: \$19, 947 salary only estimate; 0% COLA increase

Sheriffs: \$1,575; 0% increase

Clerks-of-court: \$1,575; 0% increase

Registers of deeds: \$1,575; 0% increase

Coroners: \$1,575; 0% increase

Probate Judges: \$1,575; 0% increase

Probate Judge Salary: Based on a salary schedule which uses base salaries determined by population categories according to the latest official United States Decennial Census. Salaries are annually adjusted using the COLA provided for state classified employees from the previous fiscal year (a 1% increase).
