CHANGES IN STATE LAW



In September of 2020, the General Assembly passed the **Broadband Accessibility Act** which authorized electric cooperatives to invest in or deploy broadband facilities and allowed for utilizing electric easements to provide broadband services, especially existing overhead or underground facilities.



Upcountry Fiber is on track to install fiber in Box 8 by September 2021, solving the issue of access for over 1/3 of all residents in **Pickens County** with no internet.
