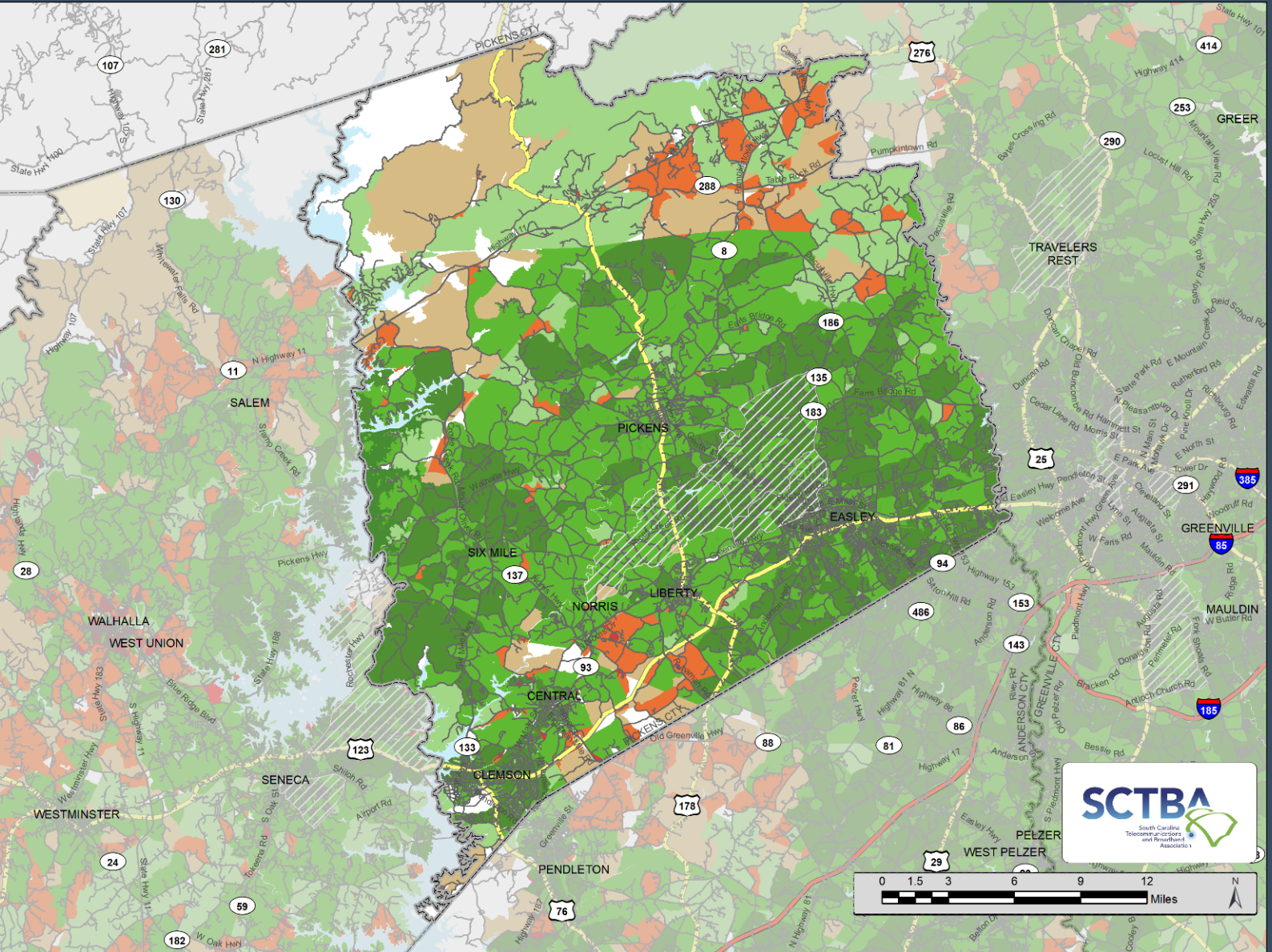
Density of Unserved Households (sq. mi.)

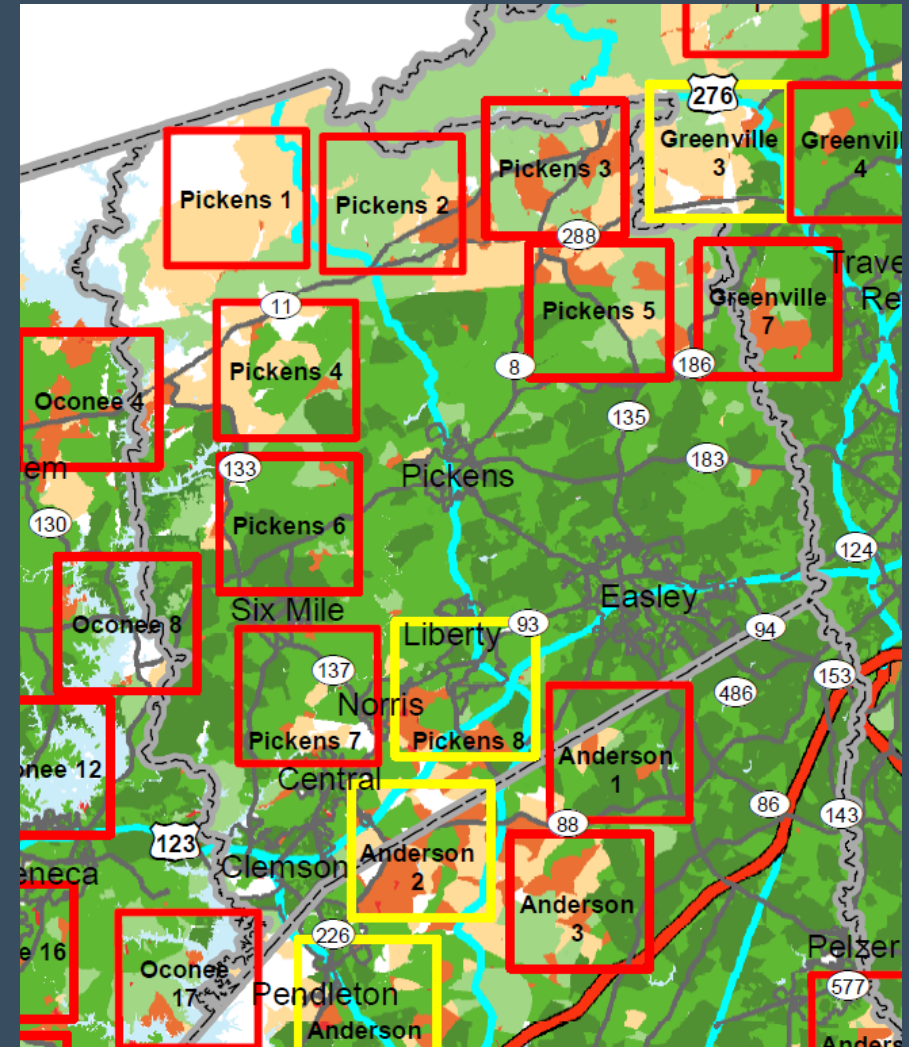
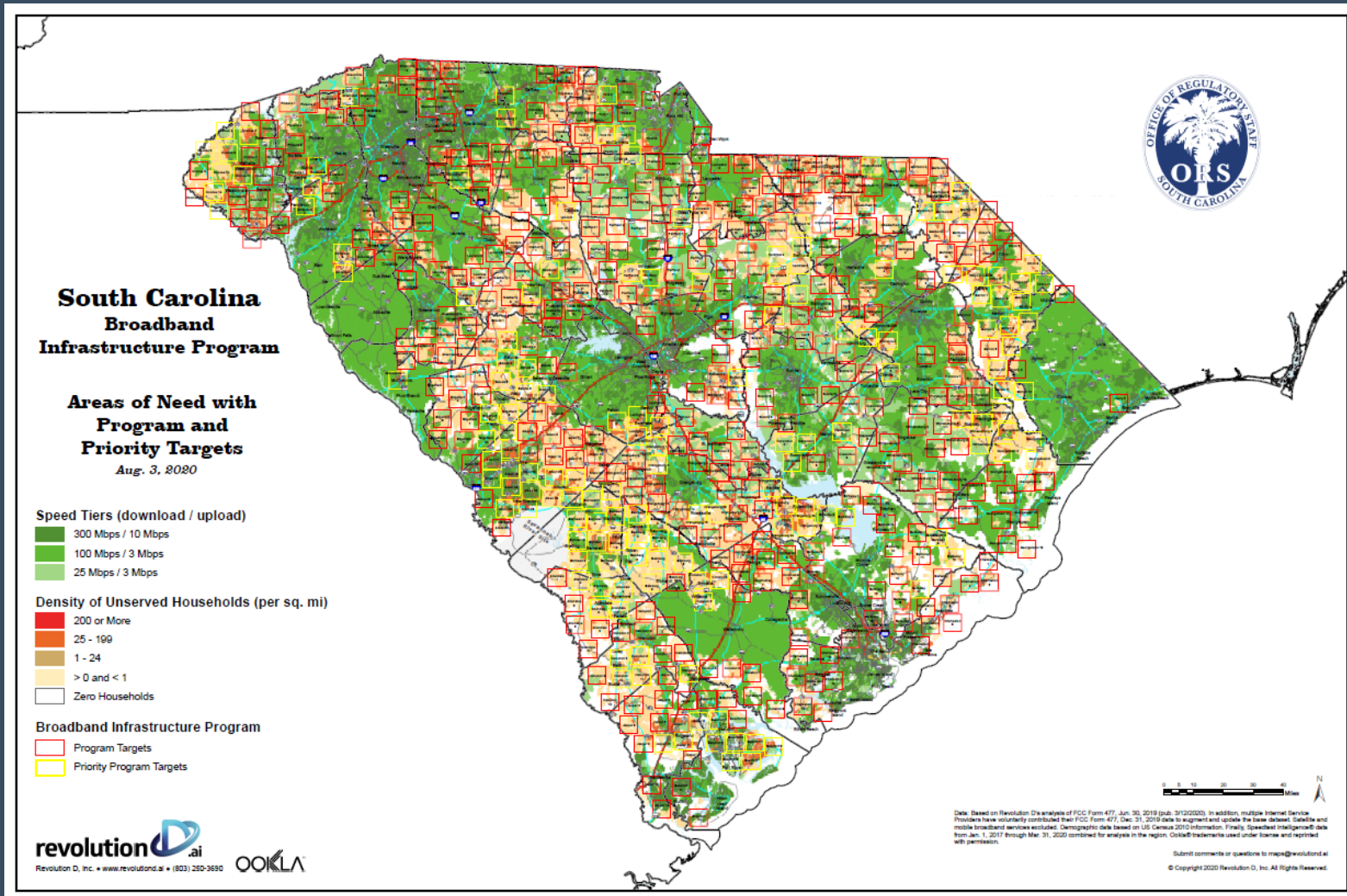

CHANGES IN STATE LAW



In September of 2020, the General Assembly passed the **Broadband Accessibility Act** which authorized electric cooperatives to invest in or deploy broadband facilities and allowed for utilizing electric easements to provide broadband services, especially existing overhead or underground facilities.

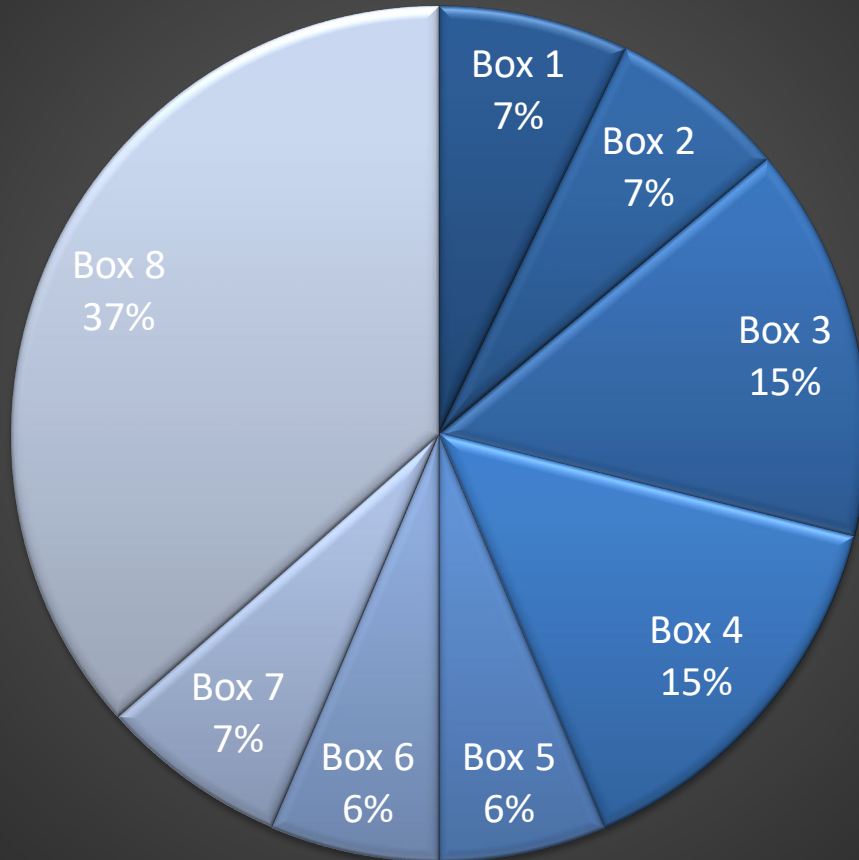

Households with No Internet



Upcountry Fiber is on track to install fiber in **Box 8** by September 2021, solving the issue of access for **over 1/3** of all residents in Pickens County with **no internet**.



“We now have a local cooperative willing to provide broadband throughout the county, with Pickens County providing incentives to ensure they build to our families quickly. What looked like a 7-year project is becoming a 2-3-year project, all due to the strong support of Pickens County.”
