


# SC Public Health Services

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#### OVERVIEW OF LOCAL HEALTH DEPARTMENT PROGRAMS & SERVICES



## **Local Health Department Services**

- DHEC manages and staffs at least one health department in each county
- Most services are provided at little to no cost to the client
- Services are billed to Medicaid or other health insurance providers
- Health departments do not provide traditional "sick care," as most services are preventive in nature or related to infectious disease control.



## **Local Health Department Services**

#### **Nutrition Services**

- WIC (Women, Infants & Children) Program
  - Nutrition services for pregnant, postpartum, or breastfeeding women, and children 5 years and under
  - $\approx$  85,494 eligible participants / mo. or 1.1 mil. / yr.
  - $\approx$  \$4.4 mil. / mo. or \$52.8 mil. / yr. is spent in SC grocery stores
  - In addition to supplemental food:
    - Breast feeding promotion and support
    - Perform nutrition assessments
    - Conduct nutrition education & counseling
    - Special formulas program (prescription)



#### Maternal Child Health Program

- Family Planning/Reproductive Health Services
  - Provide programs & education to help families plan their pregnancies
- Pregnancy Testing
- Postpartum/Newborn Home Visits from a Nurse
  - Service for Medicaid-eligible moms with a new baby
- Children & Youth w/Special Healthcare Needs
  - Objective is to improve the system of care for low incomes families or in areas with limited availability of care
  - For families whose children have developmental delays or disabling conditions



#### **Preventive Health Program**

- Sexually Transmitted Infections (STI) Diagnosis & Treatment
  - We test for HIV, syphilis, gonorrhea, chlamydia, & other STIs
- STI Fast Track (can be done out in the community)
  - A quick, 15-minute appointment to get tested for STIs
  - Can be done out in the community (Mobile Units)
- Disease Investigation Specialists
  - Perform Surveillance & intervention work
  - Work with special populations with increased risk for STIs & HIV

#### **Tuberculosis (TB) Program**

• Testing, diagnosis, treatment & management of TB clients



## **Local Health Department Services**

#### Vaccinations

- Childhood vaccines: we offer the complete vaccine series that children need
  - No cost through the federal Vaccines for Children program
- Select adult vaccines are offered
  - Flu, pneumonia, tetanus/whooping cough, etc.
  - In many cases, costs are limited to the \$25 administration fee



## Local Health Department Services

### Epidemiology (EPI) Program

- Infectious & chronic disease surveillance, investigation, treatment, education, & prevention
- Epi. staff perform routine surveillance for over 75 diseases
  - Rabies
  - Eastern Equine Encephalitis
  - COVID
  - Monkeypox
- Analyze data & information pertaining to county's & neighborhoods
  - Develop reports and presentations (Data Walks)



#### **Community Systems Staff- Health Educators**

- Community Health Assessment (CHA) & Community Health Improvement Plan (CHIP)
  - Work with partners to perform assessments based on local input & reflect the overall health needs of a community
  - We partner with the local hospital to inform their Community Health Needs Assessment (CHNA) - required by IRS
- Policy & Systems Change Efforts
  - Substance Use Tobacco & other drug use
  - Nutrition & Physical Activity Healthy Eating / Active Living



#### **Community Systems Staff (Continued)**

- Facilitate Community Coalitions Health Planning
  - Plan & implement community health programs
  - Work to safeguard & improve the physical, mental, & social well-being of the community as a whole
  - Analyze data & information pertaining to counties, communities, & neighborhoods to develop reports & presentations (Data Walks)
  - Work with local county & city planners on design healthier communities
