Institute of Government

The South Carolina Association of Counties, in cooperation with the Joseph P. Riley Jr. Center for Livable Communities, College of Charleston will hold the **Institute of Government for County Officials** (Level I, Level II, and Advanced) on Saturday, August 3 and Sunday, August 4, 2019.

Credit for Level II courses will be given to county officials who have graduated from Level I or are within nine (9) hours of graduating from Level I.

Each course is three credit hours. Credits for courses are valid for four years. To receive a certificate for Level I, 27 hours of instruction, including 18 hours of required and 9 hours of elective topics, must be completed. To receive a certificate for Level II, 18 hours of instruction in Level II topics must be completed. There is no certificate program for the Advanced Level.
