

# 2023 Scholarship Application

## **Eligibility**

- 1. In May, a \$2,500 scholarship will be awarded to a graduating high school senior who is a resident of Lexington County (2023 SCAC President's home county). This is a one-time award. At the same time, SCAC's Board of Directors Scholarship Program will award \$2,500 scholarships to four graduating high school seniors who are residents of counties chosen by lot by the Association. Berkeley, Calhoun, Dillon, and Lancaster counties were selected in the draw for 2023, and a scholarship will be awarded to a resident of each county. These are one-time awards.
- 2. Applicants must be planning to attend a South Carolina college/university or two-year technical college in the fall of 2023.
- 3. The scholarship recipient will be selected by a Scholarship Selection Committee. The scholarship will be awarded based on the accuracy and completeness of the application; the essay; grades; school activities; and community activities. The committee may also consider need as it relates to the receipt of other scholarship awards. The scholarship check will be sent directly to the school to which the recipient has been accepted.
- 4. All applications must be submitted or postmarked by February 1, 2023.
