

# 2021 BOARD OF DIRECTORS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

### **Eligibility**

- 1. In May, SCAC's Board of Directors Scholarship Program will award \$2,500 scholarships to four graduating high school seniors who are residents of counties chosen by lot by the Association. **Dorchester**, **Richland**, **Saluda**, **and Spartanburg counties** were selected in the draw for 2021, and **a scholarship will be awarded to a resident of each county.**
- 2. Applicants must be planning to attend a South Carolina college/university or two-year technical college in the fall of 2021.
- 3. The scholarship recipients will be selected by Scholarship Selection Committees. Each scholarship will be awarded based on the accuracy and completeness of the application; the essay; grades; school activities; and community activities. The committees may also consider need as it relates to the receipt of other scholarship awards. Scholarship checks will be sent directly to the schools to which the recipients have been accepted.
