February 26th - Groundskeepers - The session will cover PPE, chainsaw safety, powered hand tools, lawn mowers, hearing conservation and heat stress awareness

Target Audience – employees and supervisors from any departments engaged in grounds keeping maintenance (parks & rec., buildings & grounds)

April 15th – Bloodborne Pathogens, First Aid & AED – the session will be a detailed discussion of the Bloodborne Pathogen Standard, First Aid and AED requirements.

Target Audience - risk managers, exposure control officers and supervisors who are responsible for managing exposures to bloodborne pathogens and providing first aid equipment for employees.

June 10th – Permit Required Confined Space General Industry & Construction – This session will cover the hazards associated with working in Confined Spaces for general maintenance as well as construction activities. We will define what is a confined space, what makes one a permit required space and the necessary steps to meet the OSHA compliance requirements.

Target Audience – managers and supervisors with exposures and employees that may enter or work around confined spaces.

August 19th – Excavation & Trenching –The session will cover the exposures associated with trenching and excavation and will include an additional information on what is necessary to meet the OSHA requirements.

October 14th – Lock Out Tag Out & Electrical Safety – The session will cover the OSHA requirements for Lock Out Tag Out while performing servicing and maintenance on electrical and mechanical equipment. Target Audience – managers and supervisors who direct employees and general employees who are engaged in servicing and maintaining mechanical and electrical equipment or have duties for general facility maintenance.
